The Animal By-Products Regulations 2005

Approval of incinerators

1. In accordance with regulation 13, 14 and 40 of the Animal By-Products Regulations 2005 and Article 12 of Regulation (EC) No 1774/2002 (as read with Commission Decision 2003/327/EC) the Secretary of State approves

to operate incinerator Make: Dowson & Mason Ltd - Model: Refupath R250 (a high capacity incinerator) on the premises to incinerate Category 1 animal by-products, namely pets and other category 1 material but excluding specified risk material (SRM) and carcasses containing SRM.

2. The incinerator shall be located at the site on the plan attached.

Temperature readings shall be monitored continuously. If the temperature in the secondary chamber falls below 855°C, an alarm will sound and a light will flash. A burner will then be lit manually. This procedure will be followed as the burner will not light automatically

3. This approval expires on 22nd November 2011
